CARRIER SERVICE UPDATES**ASIA-EUR**

Maersk Line announces a series of adjustments to their Asia-Europe network. The following changes will be effective in November:

- The AE8 service will temporarily be removed.
- The AE1 and AE10 services will be linked to accommodate AE8 port calls. They will be expanded into Scandinavia to insure that there are no gaps due to the AE8 suspension.
- The following Asia-Mediterranean services will be adjusted to widen the range of direct port combinations: AE3, AE6, and Ae11.
 - A vessel will be added to the AE3 service for additional operational contingencies in the Black Sea ports. There will be two new calls at Qingdao and Yantian.
 - Valencia and Tangier will be added to the AE6 service.
 - Improved transit times to Genoa and Fos Sur Mer will enhance the AE11 service. A new call from Fuzhou to Mediterranean ports will be added. The current call to Algiers will be moved to the AE6 service.
